Approved in writing.</p> <p>b. Submitted at least six weeks in advance.</p> <p>c. For no more than five consecutive work days, unless approved four months prior by the attending and program director.</p> <p>d. Distributed throughout the year rather than clustered into a single rotation or calendar month.</p> <p>e. Taken within the academic year ending June 30. Vacation time may not be carried over per Wayne State University School of Medicine GME policy.</p> <p>f. The American Board of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation stipulates that a resident should not be absent from the residency training for more than six weeks. Any leave time or absence beyond six weeks would need to be made up by arrangement with the Program Director. "Leave time" includes sick leave, vacation, maternity leave, leave for locum tenens, or work in another institution that is not an ACGME accredited residency.
